## **Certainty in Uncertain Times**

"Do not worry or be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will have worries and anxieties of its own. Sufficient for each day is its own trouble."

Matthew 6:34

I have repeated this verse in my head many times over the past six months—trying to get it in my bones. We are living in a season where it feels the world has flipped on its head. The insecurity of broken relationships, unemployment, disappointment, and illness is rampant. What we thought we knew no longer exists and each day seems to bring new revelations that fail to lift our spirits. It seems impossible to anticipate or control what tomorrow will bring. How do we live in certainty in uncertain times?

Recently I read the book of Ruth, a story of a family who moves from Bethlehem to the country of Moab to escape famine. Following their arrival, the father dies. His sons marry Moabite women and ten years later the boys also die leaving three women widows and childless. The story is fraught with uncertainty and anxiety. The man's wife, Naomi, decides to go back to Bethlehem and tells her daughters-in-law to return to their families in Moab. One does, but Ruth vows to stay with Naomi.

Where you go I will go, and where you lodge I will lodge. Your people shall be my people and your God my God. Ruth 1:16

To make what we believe stick and transform the way we live we need to repeat it often. What is it you believe? What words do you speak that are altering your life? For what is in our heart will come out our mouth. I am making a daily choice to say, "I Trust In You God." Say it with me...

It was Ruth's vow that led her to follow Naomi to Bethlehem where the Lord guided her to a godly man named Boaz. They had no idea they would become great-grandparents of King David and part of the genealogy of Jesus Christ. Their repeated faithfulness, loyalty, and commitment to follow the Lord in the little things turned into something unexpectedly amazing! Like Ruth, what we do and affirm in the seemingly insignificant moments of our private life will establish our public legacy.
